To improve the care on the ward of young people with a new diagnosis of diabetes

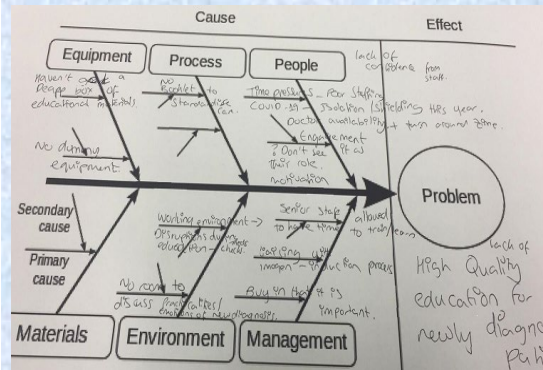
Improvement Journey

Our Interventions

Recognising that there are areas to be improved upon in the diagnosis period, the team has created an Admission Pack to be completed on the ward whenever a young person is admitted with a new diabetes diagnosis. This will standardise care and ensure every child receives the same high standard of care at the start of their diagnosis.
